

- b. The appropriate dress for LADIES comprises golf shoes, sports socks, tailored shorts or skirt or pants and a collared blouse or "T" shirt.

System 36

System 36 is a same-day handicapping system. It allows golfers who do not have a handicap index to play golf tournaments and compete for low-net titles or prizes. The "handicap" is determined following the round according to System 36 structures.

Here's how System 36 works: Throughout the round, the golfer accrues points based on the following formula:

- Double bogey or worse - 0 points
- Bogey - 1 point
- Par or better - 2 points

At the end of the round, points earned are tallied. The total is subtracted from 36, and the resulting number is the golfer's handicap allowance. His net score can then be computed using his System 36 handicap allowance.

For example, let's say you go out and shoot 90, and along the way to that 90 you have seven pars, nine bogeys, and two double-bogeys or worse.

First, calculate your accrued points:

$$\begin{aligned} 7 \text{ (pars)} \times 2 \text{ (points per par)} &= 14 \\ 9 \text{ (bogeys)} \times 1 \text{ (point per bogey)} &= 9 \\ 2 \text{ (doubles or worse)} \times 0 \text{ (points per double)} &= 0 \end{aligned}$$

So your point total is 23. Now, subtract this total from 36:

$$36 - 23 = 13$$

So 13 is your handicap allowance. Now apply this to your gross score:

$$90 - 13 = 77$$

And 77 is your net score based on System 36 handicapping

Shot Gun Start

- All golfers are requested to be at the club house by 1230hrs. Registration and lunch will be from 1130hrs onwards. Short Gun start will be from 1300hrs.
- Latecomers will not be allowed to participate. Even if allowed to start late, the appropriate penalty of two points or disqualification will be imposed at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- Tee boxes to be used shall be as follows:
 - **Men** - **WHITE Tee**
 - **Ladies** - **RED Tee**

Flight I/C

- The lowest handicap member on each flight shall be the Flight I/C. He/she shall be responsible to ensure that proper scoring is done, cards are exchanged in rotation, golf rules and etiquette are followed, speed of play is maintained and handle any other golfing or general matters on the flight.

Ties

- In the event of a tie for any position, the count back method shall be adopted to determine the winner. Sequence of count back shall be based on the PSG's standard methods used.

Individual Prizes

- The following Novelty Prizes will be awarded:
 - **Nearest the Pin** (2 Par 3 Holes)
 - **Longest Drive**
 - **Nearest the Line**
- All prize winners (including novelty prize winners) must complete the 18 holes (lesser in case of inclement weather) and submit a completed scorecard to be eligible.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to increase, decrease or change the list of prizes at their discretion.

Speed Up Play

- As this is a stableford tournament, players are requested to play without undue delay. If a player is out of contention for a hole (i.e. NET double bogey or more) please pick up your ball, score ZERO for the hole and proceed to the next tee box.
- On the green, a putt **within one putter length (minus the grip) is a "Gimme"** on the next stroke. Pick up your ball and **ADD one stroke** to your score for that hole.
- The above "Gimme" rule **DOES NOT** apply to players who are competing for the Best Gross Prize, who must putt out every hole.

Inclement Weather

- In the event of poor weather, no rain checks will be issued. If everyone has completed at least 9 holes, the score for 9 holes will be used to determine the winner. In the event of a total "washout", all prizes (except for the trophies) will be awarded on a lucky draw basis.

Score Cards

- Please submit your duly signed scorecards with gross scores per hole immediately upon completing your round to the club Official at the Clubhouse. Any card not submitted within 30 minutes of completing the game shall be disqualified at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

Tournament Rules & Decisions

- All complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred to the Chairman, Organising Committee immediately. The Organising Committee's decisions on all matters shall be final. No disputes on scores shall be entertained after the results have been announced.

Prize Giving Dinner Reception

- A Prize Giving Dinner Reception has been organised for all golfers after the game. Spouses accompanying will be charged an additional \$30.00. For other guests, other than the spouse of the golfer, will be charged \$50.00. The dinner details are as follows:
